Lunch Bunch is a popular “elective” here at Country Children’s House. The children enjoy eating together and socializing, comparing lunches and lunch boxes and discussing a wide variety of topics. This time gives Lunch Bunch teachers an opportunity to introduce and/or reinforce lessons students have learned in their classes: counting food items (Math), naming foods that begin with the letter of the week (Language), Identifying healthy foods (Science), and cleaning up after ourselves (Practical Life). We have even been known to create food art! When we are not eating, we play with recess toys, do crafts, play games, sing songs and exercise. On nice days we play outside on the playground.

What to pack for lunch: Parents need to pack a lunch each day from home. We ask that you send drinks in a thermos-type bottle that your child can open and close. No Capri Suns or drink boxes. Please pack food in a Bento/meal-prep type box that fits in their lunch box and that your child can open and close. Please have all food items opened and unwrapped inside their Bento/meal-prep box. *Please label everything with your child’s name.

Drop off & pick up: Children simply go with the Lunch Bunch teacher at 11:30 AM when the Montessori session ends. At pick up at 1:00 PM, we use Carline as well.

School closings/delays: In the event that Noblesville Schools are closed, Country Children’s’ House will be closed and there will be no Lunch Bunch that day. If CCH is on a one hour delay, Lunch Bunch will be in session as usual with regular time pick up.
